Version 15.0.1205.21

- Updated Client/Server installs to allow multiple concurrent users

- Updated the program to be compatible with Windows 7 (64-Bit) machines

- Corrected the misspelling of the word Excused on the Absentee Calendar report when Previewing it and printing it
- Fixed the Edit functionality for Employee Benefits to no longer auto-populate the End Date when editing
